
# Porsche Gettysburg Fun Run

Welcome to the 1<sup>st</sup> annual Porsche Gettysburg Fun Run. This guide will help you navigate all of the twists and turns and, there's quite a few so pay attention!

This is a fun run gang. It's not a race. This will be an excellent drive put together by a team of local experts who know these roads. Please keep in mind, these are public roads so please, drive safely and respect the other motorists along the route so they, in turn, will have the opportunity to respect you. This is a full day event. Here are some things to remember for this type of trip:

- 1. Start with a full tank. This is a 100+ mile day.
- 2. Start "yourself" with a full tank. Get a good breakfast.
- 3. Bring water. Hydration is good.
- 4. Use the restroom prior to the next segment.
- 5. Relax and have fun. If you get caught at a light, the lead will be conscious and will try to keep everyone together. We'll have an enclosed car hauler running sweep if you have any problems.

We're going to assume you all have the capacity to get yourself out of bed in time to make it to the AACA museum by 8:45AM. We're gathering at the museum as a group and, they've requested we enter as a group (when the doors open) at 9:00AM. We'll have a fun two hours seeing, drooling over and photographing some amazing Porsche automobiles. Our target departure (from inside the museum) will be 11:00AM. Please be available in the parking lot for a quick drivers meeting as we have a fairly large group.

#### Drive "A" - 11:15AM to 12:30PM

The first portion of the drive will take us through some of the most beautiful rolling hills and Americana that only Pennsylvania has to offer. This is the longest segment of the day so we've selected a fantastic "themed" restaurant for lunch so get ready to get your Sauerkraut face on! Parking is in the rear of the restaurant. Overflow parking is on the street.

- 1. Head north on Museum Dr toward PA-39 E/Hershey Rd 364 ft
- 2. Turn right onto PA-39 E/Hershey Rd.

Continue to follow PA-39 E - 1.3 mi

- 3. Turn right onto PA-39 E/Hersheypark Drive 2.0 mi
- 4. Merge onto US-322 W/Paxton St via the ramp to Harrisburg/I-83
  - Continue to follow US-322 W 6.8 mi
- 5. Keep right at the fork, follow signs for Carlisle/Lewistown/I-83 S/US-322 W/I-81 164 ft  $\,$
- 6. Keep left at the fork, follow signs for I-83 S/Harrisburg and merge onto I-83 S 7.5 mi
- 7. Take exit 39A for PA-114/Lewisberry Rd 0.2 mi
- 8. Turn left onto PA-114 W/Lewisberry Rd 2.5 mi
- 9. Turn right to stay on PA-114 W/Lewisberry Rd. Continue to follow Lewisberry Rd - 4.3 mi
- 10. Turn right onto PA-177 S/Rosstown Rd 6.0 mi
- 11. Continue straight onto PA-74 N/Carlisle Rd 1.5 mi
- 12. Continue onto York St 0.2 mi
- 13. Continue onto Wellsville Rd 1.4 mi
- 14. Slight left onto S Peiffer Rd 1.1 mi
- 15. Slight right onto Pine Woods Rd 0.3 mi
- 16. Turn left onto Kralltown Rd 0.7 mi
- 17. Turn right onto Pine Ridge Rd 1.2 mi
- 18. Continue onto State Route 4008/Davidsburg Rd 0.5 mi
- 19. Turn left onto PA-194 S/Baltimore Pike Continue to follow PA-194 S - 7.8 mi
- 20. At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto W King St Destination will be on the right 495 ft



This segment of the trip is 45.5 mi and should take use about 1 hour 10 minutes to complete.

#### **Drive "B" - 2:00PM to 2:30PM**

The next portion of the drive is rather short, just a 20 minute romp down the road to Gettysburg. The park roads are free but there is a charge to visit the museum and the movie. Gettysburg is probably the single most defining moment in the history of a young United States. This should be an exciting visit. We will park and stage in the large parking lot by the welcome center. We have 3.5 hours scheduled for the park so please feel free to branch off and explore at your own pace. There will be a group auto tour If you plan to attend the next segment (drive to the Mechanicsburg covered bridge) then please stage in the parking lot at 5:45PM. If you would like to head into the town and do some souvenir hunting... you're free to head back at your leisure.

- 21. Head west on U.S. 30 W/W King St/Lincoln Way E toward Upper Alley Continue to follow U.S. 30 W/Lincoln Way E 4.0 mi
- 22. At the traffic circle, continue straight onto U.S. 30 W/Lincoln Way W 9.8 mi
- 23. At the traffic circle, take the 3rd exit onto Baltimore St/Lincoln Square Continue to follow Baltimore St 453 ft



This segment of the trip is 13.9 mi and should take us about 21 minutes to complete

## Drive "C" – 6:00PM to 6:30PM

A short drive up US-15 will take us to Messiah College and one of the scenic covered bridges that Eastern Pennsylvania is famous for. We plan to stage for a photo opt by the bridge and then head back to the Hershey/Harrisburg area. A few of us will be heading to "Underdogs Sports Bar & Grill" in Harrisburg which is where the fun run officially ends.

- 24. Head north on Baltimore St toward W Zerfing Alley 200 ft
- 25. At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto U.S. 30 E/York St 2.3 mi
- 26. Merge onto US-15 N via the ramp to Harrisburg 24.9 mi
- 27. Take the Lisburn Rd exit 0.2 mi
- 28. Slight right onto W Lisburn Rd 0.6 mi
- 29. Turn right onto Grantham Rd 0.2 mi
- 30. Turn right onto College Ave

Destination will be on the left - 397 ft

#### This segment of the trip will be 28.3 mi and should take about 32 minutes to complete



## **Drive "D" – 7:00PM to 7:15PM**

Underdogs Sports Bar & Grill 3100 Paxton St. Harrisburg, PA 17111

- 31. Head northeast on College Ave 397 ft
- 32. Take the 1st left toward Grantham Rd. 220 ft
- 33. Continue straight onto Grantham Rd. 0.2 mi
- 34. Turn left onto W Lisburn Rd 0.5 mi
- 35. Merge onto US-15 N via the ramp to Harrisburg 6.0 mi
- 36. Take the exit onto PA-581 E toward I-83/Harrisburg/Hershey 2.2 mi
- 37. Merge onto I-83 N 3.3 mi
- 38. Take exit 45 toward Paxton St 0.1 mi
- 39. Merge onto S 32nd St 0.1 mi
- 40. Turn right onto Paxton St.

Destination will be on the right - 272 ft

#### This segment of the trip is 12.7 mi and should take us about 16 minutes to complete
